




#### Which year group is your child(ren) in? 32 responses









#### My child enjoys learning at school.




#### My child's learning is progressing well.






#### The school keeps me well informed about my child's progress.




#### My child feels safe at school.




#### My child is treated fairly at school.




#### I feel staff really know my child as an individual to support them well. 32 responses




#### My child benefits from school clubs and activities provided outside of the classroom. 32 responses






